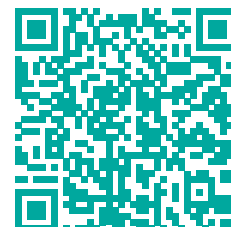

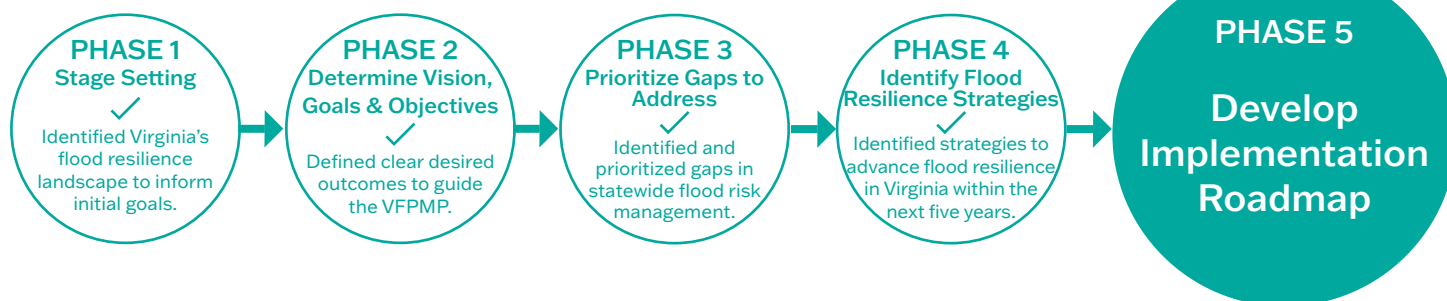
Virginia Flood Protection Master Plan

PHASE 5: IMPLEMENTATION ROADMAP

Purpose:

Collaborate with VFPMP stakeholders to organize, advance, and evaluate actions to be taken during the implementation phase of the plan to achieve the objectives of the VFPMP.

During the Implementation Roadmap phase, the Plan Development Team:

Reviewed identified strategies and developed actions to address priority gaps and achieve the plan's objectives.

Conducted interviews, held virtual feedback sessions, an in-person workshop, and a Flood Resilience Advisory Committee meeting to receive stakeholder feedback.

Integrated stakeholder feedback to develop a living roadmap for state-level leaders to use during the implementation stage.
