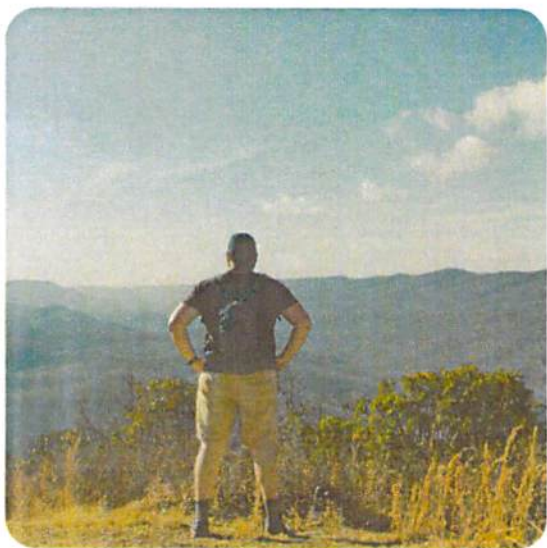

What is Geocaching?

Geocaching is a game that combines technology with old fashioned treasure hunting. Participants track caches using GPS systems and coordinates. Caches are small containers with "treasure" inside, perhaps a dime-store trinket or other unique souvenir. Gamers can sign the log book and see how many other people have found the cache. Caches have been hidden in parks, cities and across all seven continents. There are probably dozens in your hometown.

How to get started.

Download the "Geocaching" app by Groundspeak Inc. on your mobile device and make sure to give the app the ability to use location. Explore the app and look for caches near you to find some here at Hungry Mother State Park as well as in other parks and public places all over. Make sure to observe posted laws, rules, and signage wherever your adventure takes you.
